Day 1: ARRIVAL DAY

Arrival at Munich Airport
 Meet your tour managers and coach drivers at the airport
 Transfer by coach to your hotel in Salzburg and check in to the HOTEL SCHERER****
 The hotel is located in a quiet residential area, within a few minutes' walk of Salzburg's city centre

After check in, head into town for lunch (at leisure) and an initial orientation of the historical centre. You'll be able to stroll through the famous and picturesque Getreidegasse, the street on which Mozart was born, with its high and narrow houses, colourful painted windows and courtyards, vaulted passageways and the original guild signs hanging overhead. You'll also have plenty of opportunity to shop, eat and drink. Don't forget to try the original Salzburger Mozartkugeln, the world

Make your own way, with tour managers, to the K & K Restaurant for dinner, an intimate, centrally-located restaurant, serving traditional Austrian food. Return to the hotel on foot after dinner

Day 2: SALZBURG / VIENNA

Breakfast buffet at your hotel
 Meet your tour managers and guides in the hotel lobby and leave for a half-day guided walking city tour of Salzburg

Welcome to Salzburg – the city of Mozart's birth! A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Salzburg is one of the best-preserved city centres north of the Alps and is internationally renowned for its baroque architecture. It also has an unparalleled reputation for its musical tradition, something which flourishes still today - indeed its beauty and vibrant musical life have made Salzburg one of Europe's foremost

You will enjoy your half day walking city tour with two licensed English speaking guides. You will see the historical town, the Cathedral, the Pegasus Fountain, the Mirabell Gardens, Mozart's birthplace (admission included), the „Landestheater“ and the area around the famous St Peter's cemetery. The tour will also include a ride in the funicular up to the fortress

Free time for lunch and independent sight-seeing / shopping

Meet your coaches and tour managers at a pre-arranged location in town and transfer to Vienna, via the Mondsee to visit the Sound of Music Wedding Church

Continue by coach to your hotel in Vienna and check in to the Airo Tower Hotel****

The hotel is located south of the city centre, next to the famous natural haven, the Oberlaa spa

 Meet your tour managers in the hotel lobby and leave by coach, with instruments, for a full day excursion to Eisenstadt, including the key sites, as well as a visit to the Joseph Haydn Conservatory followed by a concert in the Conservatory Hall

*Welcome to The Haydn Conservatory
 A living memorial to Joseph Haydn, the conservatory opened its doors to students and pupils more than three decades ago. It has a reputation for quality and an international character with students from all over the world.*

You will meet the Head of the Conservatory and students, who will take you on a tour round the school

*Welcome to Eisenstadt – “Haydn City”
 Eisenstadt is the smallest regional capital in Austria. It is well-known as “Haydn City”, because of Haydn’s strong connections with the Esterhazy Palace, where he was both composer in residence and director of music.*

Lunch at leisure in Eisenstadt
 Half day guided city tour of Eisenstadt with two licensed English speaking guides, including admission to the Esterhazy Palace

Your walking tour will incorporate the Rathaus, Plague Column, Franciscan Cloister, Hayden House, Esterhazy Palace, Jewish Quarter and the Haydn Church.

Walk back to the Haydn Conservatory for your rehearsal

Dinner in the Haydnbrau, a traditional brewery serving delicious local food

Return to the Conservatory for your concert in the main auditorium

Return by coach to Vienna

Day 4: VIENNA

 Meet tour managers and guides in hotel lobby and leave by coach for a half day guided city tour of Vienna with local English speaking guides

Welcome to Vienna – the capital of Austria! Vienna is now also included into the list of UNESCO heritage sites because of its unique appearance. The historic centre of Vienna is architecturally rich with baroque palaces and gardens, alongside grand buildings, monuments and parks from the late 19th century. The former capital of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, Vienna, is universally acknowledged to be the musical capital of Europe.

Your tour will include the Karntnerstrasse, St. Stephen s Cathedral, Graben, Opera House, Hotel Sacher, the highlights around the Ringstrasse including the Rathaus, Volksgarten, Hofburg and Museums of Science and Fine Art, and the garden of Schonbrunn Palace

Lunch and afternoon at leisure
 Rehearsal at the Pfarrkirche St. Josef Weinhaus, where the evening concert will take place
 Return by coach to your hotel for dinner and time to refresh and change for this evening s concert
 Return to hotel

Day 5: VIENNA

 Return by coach to hotel
 Lunch and afternoon at leisure
 Take U-Bahn (Vienna subway) to Smutnys for dinner, located near the State Opera and offering delicious Viennese home cooking
 Take U-Bahn to the Volksoper to see a performance of Das Land des Lachelns, the operetta by Franz Lehar
 Return to hotel after dinner

 Check out of hotel and leave with tour managers for Budapest
 Arrive at and check in to Hotel Ibis Hero's Square
 The hotel is located next to the City Park, just 10 minutes from the city centre

Lunch at the Restaurant Citadella
 Half day city tour of Budapest by coach with tour managers and two licensed English speaking guides

Welcome to Budapest - A fabulous city or should we say cities
 After the union of the three cities Pest, Buda and Ó Buda in 1873, the capital of Hungary received the name of Budapest. The two sides of the City, Pest and Buda, are separated by the River Danube, but linked by nine bridges. Despite being a cosmopolitan city, Budapest, with its unique cultural heritage, has not lost any of its magic or charm

Your tour will include Hero's Square, Andrassy Boulevard, the State Opera, St. Stephen's Cathedral, the Parliament building, Royal Castle, Fisherman's Bastion, Matthias Church and the Gellert Hill
